Public enterprise defined. 7 As used in this Article, "public enterprise" includes: Water supply and distribution systems. 8 (1) Wastewater collection, treatment, and disposal systems of all types, including 9 (2) 10 septic tank systems or other on-site collection or disposal facilities or systems. Solid waste collection and disposal systems and facilities. 11 (3) 12 Airports. (4) Off-street parking facilities. 13 (5) Public transportation systems. 14 (6) Stormwater management programs designed to protect water quality by 15 (7) controlling the level of pollutants in, and the quantity and flow of, stormwater 16 and structural and natural stormwater and drainage systems of all types. 17 Communications service as defined in G.S. 160A-340(3)." 18 (8) **SECTION 2.** Article 15 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by 19

adding a new section to read as follows:

"§ 153A-274.2. Authority to provide communications service as a public enterprise.

A county may provide communications service to the county and its citizens. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, a county may not provide communications service outside its borders. For purposes of this act, the term "communications service" has the same meaning as in G.S. 160A-340(3). The provisions of Article 16A of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes shall not apply to the provision of communications service by a county."

SECTION 3. This act applies only to the following counties: Edgecombe and Halifax.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
