6		<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 10B-20(c) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7	"(c)	A notary shall not perform a notarial act if any of the following apply:

9		(7) The notary is an elected public official or a candidate for public office and the
10		record to be notarized is an absentee ballot executed in accordance with
11		G.S. 163A-1310(a)."
12		<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to absentee
13	ballots executed on or after that date.
