Short Title: Durham/Nonmunicipal Utility Relocation Costs. (Local) Sponsors: Senators Woodard and McKissick (Primary Sponsors). Referred to: Rules and Operations of the Senate March 18, 2019 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF DURHAM TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO REIMBURSE NONMUNICIPAL UTILITY OWNERS FOR UTILITY RELOCATION **COSTS** WITHOUT **COMPLYING** WITH THE STATE'S CONTRACTING LAWS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Chapter VII of the Charter of the City of Durham, being Chapter 671 of the Session Laws of 1975, as amended, is amended by adding a new section to read as follows: "Sec. 128. Reimbursement to nonmunicipal utility owners for relocation costs. The City is authorized to reimburse a nonmunicipal utility owner for utility relocation costs that exceed the dollar threshold in G.S. 143-129 and G.S. 141-131(a) without complying with the requirements of Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
