A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE NONRESIDENT DEPENDENTS OF ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE MEMBERS AND VETERANS ELIGIBLE FOR NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 116-281(3) reads as rewritten: "(3) The student must meet at least one of the following: a. Qualify as a legal resident of North Carolina and as a resident for tuition purposes under the criteria set forth in G.S. 116-143.1 and in accordance with definitions of residency that may from time to time be adopted by the Board of Governors of The University of North

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2019, and applies beginning with the award of scholarships for the 2020-2021 academic year.
