A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION JUST COMPENSATION INTEREST RATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 24-1 reads as rewritten:

"Except as otherwise provided in G.S. 136-113, the The legal rate of interest shall be eight percent (8%) per annum for such time as interest may accrue, and no more."

SECTION 2. G.S. 136-113 reads as rewritten:

"§ 136-113. Interest as a part of just compensation.

To said amount awarded as damages by the commissioners or a jury or judge, the judge shall, as a part of just compensation, add interest at the legal rate <u>as provided in G.S. 24-1</u> on said amount from the date of taking to the date of judgment; but interest shall not be allowed from the date of deposit on so much thereof as shall have been paid into court as provided in this Article. For purposes of this section, the term "legal rate" means the prime lending rate, as published by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System on the first business day of the calendar month immediately preceding the date of taking. The legal rate established under this section shall not exceed the legal rate set in G.S. 24-1. Interest shall accrue on the difference between the deposit and judgment thereafter as provided in G.S. 24-1."

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to causes of action filed on or after that date.
