3	"§ 115C-47. Powers and duties generally.				
4	In addition to the powers and duties designated in G.S. 115C-36, local boards of education				
5	shall have the power or duty:

7	(4)	To Regulate Extracurricular Activities Local boards of education shall			
8		make all rules and regulations necessary for the conducting of extracurricular			
9		activities in the schools under their supervision, including a program of			
10		athletics, where desired, without assuming liability therefor; provided, that all			
11		interscholastic athletic activities shall be conducted in accordance with rules			
12		and regulations prescribed by the State Board of Education. The local board			
13		of education's rules and regulations shall include that a high school student			
14		who attends a home school or private school that does not offer a particular			
15		extracurricular activity shall be permitted to participate in the extracurricular			
16		activity at the base public high school for the student's address or, if the base			
17		school does not offer the activity, at the public high school offering that			
18		activity closest to the student's base public high school. A public high school			
19		student shall be permitted to participate in an extracurricular activity not			
20		offered at the student's school at a public high school offering the activity that			
21		is closest to the student's school. The terms and conditions applicable to a			
22		student regularly enrolled at the public high school shall also apply to students			
23		who participate in an extracurricular activity at the school as provided by this			
24		subdivision, except that the public high school may charge a reasonable fee			
25		for participation to a student who is not enrolled in the school as established			
26		by the local board of education in accordance with subdivision (6) of this			
27		section.
