5	INSTITUTIONS AND COMMUNITY COLLEGES IN THIS STATE.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. G.S. 116-143.1 is amended by adding new subsections to read:
8	"(n) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a person who meets all of the
9	following qualifications shall be accorded resident tuition status:
10	(1) The person received a high school diploma from a secondary school or high
11	school within North Carolina or received a high school equivalency diploma
12	within North Carolina.
13	(2) The person attended North Carolina schools for a minimum of two
14	consecutive years immediately prior to completing high school.
15	(3) The person is a beneficiary of the federal Deferred Action for Childhood
16	Arrivals (DACA) initiative and provides documentation to the constituent
17	institution or community college to which the person is enrolled
18	demonstrating that the person is a DACA beneficiary.
19	(4) The person satisfies the admission standards for the constituent institution or
20	community college to which the person applied and has secured admission
21	and enrolled as a student at the constituent institution or community college.
22	(o) Any information obtained as part of the process of applying for in-State tuition
23	pursuant to subsection (n) of this section shall be confidential and is not a public record."
24	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2019, and applies beginning with
25	the 2019-2020 academic year.
