16	Whereas, rhododendron is not only a popular landscaping plant but also provides		
17	nectar for hummingbirds and pollinating insects such as bees; and		
18 19	Whereas, many North Carolinians and tourists visit the Blue Ridge Mountains in early summer to see the spectacular show of rhododendron along the Parkway and Roan Mountain,		
19 20	which has 600 acres of naturally occurring Catawba rhododendron making it the largest

1 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 2 Natural and Cultural Resources the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) in nonrecurring funds 3 for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to promote the rhododendron as the official State shrub as 4 established in Section 1 of this act.

5 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2020.
