12			school pursuant to G.S. 115C-366 or (ii) enrolled in a

15			Carolina, during the spring semester prior to the school year		
16			for which the student is applying.

For the 2027-2028 fiscal year and each fiscal year thereafter, there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Reserve the sum of one hundred forty-four forty-six million eight hundred forty thousand dollars (\$144,840,000) (\$146,840,000) to be used for the purposes set forth in this section. When developing the base budget, as defined by G.S. 143C-1-1, for each fiscal year specified in this subsection, the Director of the Budget shall include the appropriated amount specified in this subsection for that fiscal year."

18 SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with
19 the award of scholarship grants for the 2021-2022 school year.
