The General	Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SI	ECTION 1.(a) For the purposes of this section, "COVID-19" shall be defined as
the Coronavirus disease 2019.	
SI	ECTION 1.(b) There is appropriated the sum of seven million seven hundred
seventy-one thousand six hundred seventy-five dollars (\$7,771,675) in nonrecurring funds for	
the 2020-202	1 fiscal year from the General Fund to the Administrative Office of the Courts to
be allocated as follows:	
(1	One million one hundred twenty-seven thousand dollars (\$1,127,000) for
	costs associated with additional emergency judges needed for clearing the

- growing backlog of cases in the court system due to COVID-19.
- Five million eight hundred five thousand dollars (\$5,805,000) for the purchase (2) of 3,000 laptops for statewide court system personnel to aid in remote working capabilities needed due to COVID-19.
- Eight hundred thirty-nine thousand six hundred seventy-five dollars (3) (\$839,675) to hire temporary staff to help statewide clerks' offices manage the growing backlog of cases in the court system due to COVID-19.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2020.
