The Executive Director shall approve the treasurer's plan upon and only upon finding that all the following requirements are satisfied: 13 14 (2)15 That the total amount to be raised from sales under all plans by the committee does not exceed ten twenty thousand dollars (\$10,000) (\$20,000) per election 16 17 cycle." 18 19 SECTION 1.(b) This section is effective when it becomes law and applies to election 20 cycles occurring on or after that date. 21 **SECTION 2.(a)** G.S. 7A-133 reads as rewritten: 22 "§ 7A-133.
