5	SECTION 1. Section 8.22 of S.L. 2013-360, as amended by Section 8.3 of S.L.		
6	2014-100, is r	repealed.	
7	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, State Board of Education		
8	Policy, TCP-A-006, as it was in effect on June 30, 2013, shall be used to determine (i) whether		
9	teachers and instructional support personnel are paid on the "M" salary schedule and (ii) whether		
10	they receive a salary supplement for academic preparation at the six-year or doctoral degree level.		
11	SECTION 3.(a) Appropriation. – There is appropriated from the General Fund to		
12	the Department of Public Instruction the sum of eight million dollars (\$8,000,000) in recurring		
13	funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to reinstate education-based salary supplements for teachers		
14	and instructional support personnel in accordance with this act.		
15		ECTION 3.(b) State Budget Act Applies. – The provisions of the State Bud	-
