SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Military Presence Stabilization Fund established in G.S. 143B-1217 a sum sufficient in recurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to be used to sustain and maintain the State's military programs and activities by providing grants for local communities or military installations, updates to strategic planning, federal advocacy, and identification of measures to increase the military value of installations.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2020.
