5	SEC	FION 1. Findings. – The General Assembly finds all of the following:
6	(1)	The coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic has devastated the
7		economy in North Carolina, caused unprecedented job loss, and significantly
8		disrupted the delivery of education by traditional four-year institutions of
9	(-)	higher education.
10	(2)	COVID-19 has caused students enrolled in four-year institutions of higher
11		education primarily receiving online instruction to seek less expensive
12		alternatives.
13	(3)	North Carolina community colleges can offer courses to students at a
14 15	(A)	significantly lower cost than four-year institutions of higher education.
15 16	(4)	Students who take courses at community colleges can successfully transfer credits to four-year institutions of higher education later in their education
17		pathways and overall have comparably positive educational outcomes to those
18		attending traditional colleges and universities at substantial savings.
19	(5)	North Carolina community colleges also offer short-term workforce training
20	(5)	courses for unemployed individuals who have lost their jobs due to
21		COVID-19, which is crucial to the recovery of the economy in North Carolina.
22	(6)	Enrollment has particularly increased in short-term workforce education due
23		to the growing emphasis of North Carolina's community colleges in meeting
24		the needs of the businesses of the State and people recognizing the value and
25		quality of a community college education.
26	SEC	FION 2. Transfer. – The State Controller shall transfer the sum of forty-one
27	million five hundred thousand dollars (\$41,500,000) from the Coronavirus Relief Reserve	
28	established in Section 2.1 of S.L. 2020-4 to the Coronavirus Relief Fund established in Section	
29	2.2 of that same act.	
30	SECTION 3. Appropriation. – There is appropriated from the Coronavirus Relief	
31	Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management (OSBM) the sum of forty-one million five	
32	hundred thousand dollars (\$41,500,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to	
33	be allocated to the Community Colleges System Office for enrollment growth at North Carolina's	
34	community colleges.

SECTION 4. Requirements. – The requirements and limitations set forth in Part I of
S.L. 2020-4 shall apply to the funds appropriated by this act. OSBM shall include the funds
transferred and appropriated under this act in the report required under Section 1.7 of S.L. 2020-4.
SECTION 5. Effective Date. – This act becomes effective July 1, 2020.
