A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REVISE MATCHING REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE FUNDING OF
REMEDIAION ACTIVITIES AT THE CHARLOTTE MOTOR SPEEDWAY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Section 13.2 of S.L. 2018-5, as amended by Section 4.2 of S.L.
2018-97, reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 13.2. Notwithstanding G.S. 130A-310.11(b), up to two million dollars
(\$2,000,000) of the funds credited to the Inactive Hazardous Sites Cleanup Fund under
G.S. 105-187.63 for the assessment and remediation of pre-1983 landfills shall instead be used
by the Department of Environmental Quality's Division of Waste Management to provide a
matching grant to Charlotte Motor Speedway, LLC, (CMS) for the purpose of remediation
activities at the Charlotte Motor Speedway in Cabarrus County. The Division shall provide one
dollar (\$1.00) for every ~~two one non-State dollars (\$2.00)~~ dollar (\$1.00) provided in kind or
otherwise, up to a maximum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the matching grant described
in this section. CMS may allocate all or a portion of the grant provided by this section to an entity
that controls CMS or an entity controlled by CMS. Entities receiving such an allocation shall be
considered a subgrantee as defined in G.S. 143C-6-23."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
