# AN ACT DIRECTING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSION TO ALLOW CERTAIN SALES DURING THE CORONAVIRUS EMERGENCY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 18B-1001(10), G.S. 18B-1001.4, and any other provision of law to the contrary, the Chairman of the ABC Commission shall allow permittees 7 with a permit issued under G.S. 18B-1001(10) to engage in retail sales for consumption off the 8 9 premises, including delivery by the permittee or the permittee's employee or independent contractor. The Chairman shall also allow permittees with a permit issued under 10 G.S. 18B-1001.4, or the permittee's employee or independent contractor, to deliver products 11 12 prepared by a permittee with a permit issued under G.S. 18B-1001(10). The Chairman shall 13 prescribe the terms and conditions under which sales and deliveries are allowed under this 14 section, including that products sold or delivered under this section meet all of the following 15 requirements:

(1) Packaged in a container with a secure lid or cap and in a manner designed to prevent consumption without removal of the lid or cap.

- (2) Sold only with food.

(3) Limited to two servings per meal or food item ordered.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the ABC Commission
the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2019-2020 fiscal year
to be used to cover costs incurred by the Commission in implementing the provisions of this act.
SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law. Section 1 of this act expires
on the date that Executive Order No. 116, Declaration of a State of Emergency to Coordinate

25 Response and Protective Actions to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19, expires or is rescinded.
