6	SECTION 1.(a) The Legislative Research Commission (LRC) shall study increasing		
7	the housing options available to adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD). As

25	with any proposed legislation and the recommended appropriation for each recommendation, to		
26	the 2023 Regular Session of the 2023 General Assembly upon its convening.		
27	SECTION 2. Effective July 1, 2022, there is appropriated from the General Fund to		
28	the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental		
29	Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000)		
30	in nonrecurring funds to be used for the Transitions to Community Living Initiative.		
31		ECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes
