| 4 | Whereas, funding for child care stabilization grants is running out; and |
| 5 | Whereas, the State continues to face a child care staffing and budget crisis; and |
| 6 | Whereas, child care facilities in this State need to be staffed to allow parents to work |
| 7 | and keep the economy going; Now, therefore, |
| 8 | The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: |
| 9 | SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Department of Health |
| 10 | and Human Services, Division of Child Development and Early Education, the sum of six |
| 11 | hundred seventy-nine million dollars (\$679,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2022-2023 |
| 12 | fiscal year to provide continued funding for child care stabilization grants consistent with similar |
| 13 | grants distributed in accordance with Section 3.2(a) of S.L. 2021-25. To receive funding under |
| 14 | this section, a grant recipient shall submit a report to the Division on the efficacy of the grant |
| 15 | funds within in one year from the date the recipient receives those funds. |
| 16 | SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2022. |
