<ul> <li>IN ADOPTING THE SCHOOL CALENDAR.</li> <li>The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:</li> <li>SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:</li> <li>"(d) Opening and Closing Dates. – Local boards of education shall determine the dates of</li> <li>opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. Except for</li> <li>year round schools, the opening date for students shall be no earlier than the Monday closest to</li> <li>August 26, and the closing date for students shall be no later than the Friday closest to June 11.</li> <li>On a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive the requirement that the</li> <li>opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26 and may allow the</li> <li>local board of education to set an opening date no earlier than the Monday closest to August 19,</li> <li>to the extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient days to accommodate anticipated</li> <li>makeup days due to school closings.
