Referred to: Local Government, if favorable, Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House March 8, 2021 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TERM OF MAYOR FROM TWO TO FOUR YEARS IN THE TOWN OF CAROLINA SHORES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Section 3.4 of the Charter of the Town of Carolina Shores, being S.L. 1998-75, as amended by Town Ordinance No. 19-6 adopted December 6, 2018, reads as rewritten: "Sec. 3.4. Selection of Mayor; Term of Office. The qualified voters of the entire Town elect the Mayor. Theodora Altreuter shall serve as Mayor to serve until the organizational meeting after the 1999 municipal election. A Mayor shall be elected in 1999 and biennially thereafter for a two-year term. In 2021, and quadrennially thereafter, a Mayor shall be elected to

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
