1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO ADOPT THE LOGGERHEAD SEA TURTLE AS THE OFFICIAL
3	SALTWATER REPTILE OF THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA.
4	Whereas, the loggerhead sea turtle is the most common sea turtle found along the
5	coast of North Carolina; and
6	Whereas, loggerhead sea turtles can live up to 50 years, growing over three feet in
7	length and weighing over 250 pounds; and
8	Whereas, loggerhead sea turtles got their name because their heads resembled logs;
9	and
10	Whereas, the diets of loggerhead sea turtles consist of horseshoe crabs, conchs,
11	whelks, and other mollusks; and
12	Whereas, female loggerhead sea turtles dig hundreds of nests on the beaches of North
13	Carolina; and
14	Whereas, a female loggerhead sea turtle can lay 100 or more eggs with hatchlings
15	appearing in about 60 days; and
16	Whereas, the State of North Carolina does not have an official saltwater reptile; Now,
17	therefore,
18	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
19	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
20	section to read:
21	"§ 145-52. State saltwater reptile.
22	The loggerhead sea turtle (Caretta caretta) is adopted as the official saltwater reptile of the
23	State of North Carolina."
24	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
