2	registration of a motor vehicle and any interest assessed under G.S. 105-330.4, the Division shall		
3	charge a late fee according to the following schedule to a person who pays the applicable		
4	registration fee required under this Article after the registration expires:		
5	(1) If the registration has	been expired for less than one month, a late fee of fifteen	
6	dollars (\$15.00).		
7	(2) If the registration ha	been expired for one month or greater, but less than two	
8	months, a late fee of	twenty dollars (\$20.00).	
9	(3) If the registration has	s been expired for two months or greater, a late fee of	
10	twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).	
11	(a1) Waiver. – The Division sha	l waive the late fee assessed under subsection (a) of this	
12	section against a person who establishes the following:
