| 8  | <b>SECTION 1.1.</b> The appropriations made in this act are for the maximum amounts                |
| 9  | necessary to provide the services required to accomplish the objectives necessary to speed the     |
| 10 | State's continuing recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic.  |

| 12 | TITLE OF ACT   |
| 13 | <b>SECTION 1.2.</b> This act shall be known as the "Pandemic Recovery Act of 2021."                |

| 15 | STATE AND FEDERAL FUNDS  |
| 16 | <b>SECTION 2.1.(a)</b> Pandemic recovery appropriations from the General Fund of the               |
| 17 | State for the maintenance of the State departments, institutions, and agencies, and for other      |
| 18 | purposes relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, as herein enumerated, are made for the biennium        |
| 19 | ending June 30, 2023, in accordance with the provisions of this act.                               |
| 20 | <b>SECTION 2.1.(b)</b> Federal funds for pandemic recovery for other related purposes              |
| 21 | as enumerated are made for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, in accordance with the provisions    |
| 22 | of this act.   |

| 24 | MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS   |
| 25 | SECTION 3.1.(a) The provisions of the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the                        |
| 26 | General Statutes, are reenacted and shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated in  |
| 27 | this act by reference.   |
| 28 | <b>SECTION 3.1.(b)</b> Except for statutory changes or other provisions that clearly               |
| 29 | indicate an intention to have effects beyond the 2021-2023 fiscal biennium, the textual provisions |
| 30 | of this act apply only to funds appropriated for, and activities occurring during, the 2021-2023   |
| 31 | fiscal biennium.   |
| 32 | <b>SECTION 3.1.(c)</b> The headings to the parts and sections of this act are a convenience        |
| 33 | to the reader and are for reference only. The headings do not expand, limit, or define the text of |
| 34 | this act, except for effective dates referring to a part.  |

SECTION 3.1.(d) If any section or provision of this act is declared unconstitutional
or invalid by the courts, it does not affect the validity of this act as a whole or any part other than
the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.
