Exemptions.** 7 The All of the following activities shall be permitted: 8 The use of ethyl alcohol for scientific, chemical, pharmaceutical, mechanical, (1) 9 and industrial purposes; purposes. 10 The use of ethyl alcohol by persons authorized to obtain it tax free, as provided (2) by federal law;law. 11 12 The use of ethyl alcohol in the manufacture and preparation of any product (3) 13 unfit for use as a beverage; beverage. The use of alcoholic beverages by licensed physicians, druggists, or dental 14 (4) surgeons for medicinal or pharmaceutical purposes; or the use of alcoholic 15 beverages by medical facilities established and maintained for the treatment 16 of patients addicted to the use of alcohol or drugs; drugs. 17 The use of grain alcohol by college, university or State laboratories, and by 18 (5) manufacturers of medicine, for compounding, mixing, or preserving 19 20 medicines or medical preparations, or for surgical purposes; purposes. The manufacture, possession, and consumption of alcoholic beverages for the 21 (5a) purpose of conducting scientific, chemical, pharmaceutical, mechanical, 22 industrial, and educational research in connection with teaching, research, or 23 extension programs conducted by, or under the supervision of, an instructor at 24 25 an accredited community college, public or private college or university, or an extension agent in connection with educational programs and activities 26 offered by the North Carolina Cooperative Extension Service; Service. 27 28

- The manufacture, importation, and possession of denatured alcohol produced (6) and used as provided by federal law; law.
- The manufacture or sale of cider or vinegar; vinegar. (7)

- The spirituous liquor to be traded or exchanged is or has been <u>c.</u> approved by the Commission for sale in this State and is not unfit for human consumption."

SECTION 2. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission shall adopt temporary rules to implement the provisions of this act. Temporary rules adopted in accordance with this section shall remain in effect until permanent rules that replace the temporary rules become effective.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2021, and applies to trades or exchanges made on or after that date.
