10		(1a) Depredation Permit. – Authorizes the taking, destruction,	transfer, removal,	
11		transplanting, or driving away of undesirable, harmful, pr	edatory, excess, or	
12	surplus wildlife or wildlife resources. Livestock or poultry owners shall be			
13	issued a depredation permit for coyotes upon request. The permit must state			
14	the manner of taking and the disposition of wildlife or wildlife resources			
15		authorized or required and the time for which the permit	is valid, plus other	
16	restrictions that may be administratively imposed in accordance with rules of			
17	the Wildlife Resources Commission. The Wildlife Resources Commission			
18		shall include in its rules implementing this subdivision (i)	a requirement that	
19	holders of depredation permits report annually utilizing an electronic mail or

7	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2021. Notwithstanding
8	G.S. 150B-21.1, the Commission may issue temporary rules to implement the provisions of this
9	act.
