The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 13 of Chapter 15 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 15-133.1. Change of venue for the prosecution of mass shootings. The Court shall not, without the consent of the defendant, grant the State's motion to change the venue of a case involving the discharge of a firearm and 10 or more victims after 90 days have passed from the date of the defendant's initial arrest upon the charges." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2021, and applies to offenses
