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- Establish minimum educational and training standards for employment and (13)continuing education for officers concerning:concerning both of the following:
 - Recognizing and appropriately interacting with (i) persons who are a. deaf or hard of hearing hearing and (ii) persons with autism spectrum disorder.
 - Drivers license and vehicle registration identifiers of (i) persons who b. are deaf or hard of hearing, as authorized by G.S. 20-7(q2), or (ii) persons with autism spectrum disorder, as authorized by G.S. 20-7(q3), including that those identifiers are optional.

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SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to drivers licenses issued on or after January 1, 2022.
