Definitions and procedures. 8 As used in this Article, unless the context clearly requires otherwise and except as 9 modified in subsection (b) of this section, the term: "Dangerous dog" means 10 (1) 11 A-a dog that: a. 12 Without provocation has killed or inflicted severe injury on a person; 1.a. 13 14 2.b. Is determined by the person or Board designated by the county or 15 municipal authority responsible for animal control to be potentially 16 dangerous because the dog has engaged in one or more of the 17 behaviors listed in subdivision (2) of this subsection. Any dog owned or harbored primarily or in part for the purpose of dog 18 b. 19 fighting, or any dog trained for dog fighting. 20 21 **SECTION 1.(b)** G.S. 67-4.5 reads as rewritten: 22 "§ 67-4.5. Local ordinances. 23 Nothing in this Article shall be construed to prevent a city or county from adopting or 24 enforcing its own program for control of dangerous dogs.dogs consistent with this Article." 25 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2021.
