A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ENACT THE BACK-TO-WORK INTEGRITY ACT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Back-to-Work Integrity Act of 2021."

Integrity Act of 2021." **SECTION 2.** Article 2C of Chapter 96 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 96-14.16. Back-to-work integrity reporting requirement.

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- (a) If an employer offers an individual employment during the work search required by G.S. 96-14.9(b), and the claimant refuses the offer made by the employer, then the employer shall report this event to the Division in accordance with procedures adopted pursuant to this section.
- (b) The Division shall establish a process by which employers may report offers of employment.
- (c) The Division shall conduct an ongoing review of the enforcement and administrative steps appropriate to ensure that claimants who refuse offers of suitable work are disqualified under G.S. 96-14.11.
- (d) Beginning September 1, 2021, and then quarterly thereafter, the Division shall report to the Joint Legislative Oversight Commission on Unemployment Insurance in compliance with this section."
- **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
