The Chief Administrative Law Judge may establish subordinate positions within the Office of Administrative Hearings, 10 make appointments to those positions, remove persons appointed to those positions, and set 11 12 salaries, within the limitations of appropriations to the Office of Administrative Hearings and subject to the State Budget Act and North Carolina Human Resources Act. The Chief 13 Administrative Law Judge is exempt from provisions of the North Carolina Human Resources 14 Act as provided by G.S. 126-5(c1)(27). All other employees of the Office of Administrative 15 Hearings are subject to the North Carolina Human Resources Act. 16
