	Duty regarding abuse and neglect. – The State Board of Education, consultation with the Superintendent of Public Instruction, shall adopt a pol to be implemented by the governing body of each public secondary school defined in G.S. 115C-105.51, to provide students in grades six through with information on child abuse and neglect, including age-appropring information on sexual abuse. This policy shall apply at public second schools under the control of the State Board of Education, including school operated under Article 9C of this Chapter. Information shall be provided the form of (i) a document provided to all students at the beginning of exchool year and (ii) a display posted in visible, high-traffic areas through each public secondary school. The document and display shall include, a	iate lary ools d in ach
	 minimum, the following information: a. Likely warning signs indicating that a child may be a victim of ab or neglect, including age-appropriate information on sexual abuse. b. The telephone number used for reporting abuse and neglect to department of social services in the county in which the local sch 	the
