The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. Chapter VII of the Charter of the City of Durham, being Chapter 671
of the Session Laws of 1975, as amended, is amended by adding a new section to read as follows:
"Sec. 128. Reimbursement to nonmunicipal utility owners for relocation costs.
The City is authorized to reimburse nonmunicipal utility owners for utility relocation costs
in the amount of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) or more without complying with the
requirements of Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes."
