7	taking foxes with weapons and for foxes and coyotes by trapping during the trapping season set		
8	by the Wildlife Resources Commission each year, with no tagging requirements prior to or after		
9	sale.		
10	"SECTIO	<b>ON 1.(b)</b> No bag limit applies to coyotes and foxes taken under this act.	
11	"SECTIO	<b>DN 1.(c)</b> This section applies only to Cabarrus, Caldwell, Cleveland, Cumb	<del>erland,</del>
12	Gaston, <u>Guil</u>	ford, Harnett, McDowell, Mitchell, Montgomery, Randolph, Rowan, Ruth	nerford,
13	Stokes, and Yancey Counties."
