A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REDUCE THE SPEED LIMITS TO TWENTY-FIVE MILES PER HOUR ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS IN DURHAM EXPERIENCING CONGESTION, AS DETERMINED BY THE CITY OF DURHAM'S TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding G.S. 20-141(b)(1), it shall be unlawful to operate a vehicle in excess of 25 miles per hour on residential streets in Durham experiencing congestion, as determined by the City of Durham's Transportation Department.

**SECTION 2.** This act only applies to the City of Durham.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2021, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
