| 8 | SECTION 1. Section 5.1 of the Charter of the Town of Holly Springs, being S.L. |
| 9 | 2003-73, as amended, reads as rewritten: |
| 10 | "Section 5.1. Tree Ordinances. |
| 11 | (a) The Town may adopt ordinances to regulate the removal and preservation of existing |
| 12 | trees and shrubs prior to as part of development within a perimeter buffer zone of up to 50 feet |
| 13 | along public roadways and property boundaries adjacent to developed properties and up to 25 |
| 14 | feet along property boundaries adjacent to undeveloped properties.projects. |
| 15 | (b) Ordinances adopted pursuant to this section shall: |

| 17 | (4) Provide that the ordinances are limited to situations where undeveloped |
| 18 | property is planned or zoned in accordance with adopted municipal plans and |
| 19 | zoning regulations. |
| 20 | (5) Provide that a survey of individual trees is not required. |

| 22 | (8) Provide that the ordinances shall be enforced as provided in G.S. 160A-175. |
| 23 | (c) Before adopting an ordinance under this section, the governing board of the |
| 24 | municipality shall hold a public hearing on the proposed ordinance. Notice of the public hearing |
| 25 | shall be given in accordance with G.S. 160A-364.G.S. 160D-601. |
