Exception for licensees under Article 2 or 4. 7 G.S. 87-1 shall not apply to a licensee under Article 2 or 4 of this Chapter of the General 8 Statutes, G.S. 87-43 shall not apply to a licensee under Article 2 of this Chapter of the General 9 Statutes, and G.S. 87-21(a)(5) shall not apply to a licensee under Article 4 of this Chapter of the 10 General Statutes when the licensee is bidding and contracting directly with the owner of a public 11 building project if: if all of the following apply: (i)(1) a <u>A</u> licensed general contractor performs all work that falls within the 12 classifications in G.S. 87-10(b) and the State Licensing Board of General 13 14 Contractor's rules; and rules. (ii)(2) the The total amount of the general contracting work so classified does not 15 exceed a percentage of the total bid price pursuant to rules established by the. 16 17 Board; and the Board. 18 (iii)(3) a A licensee with the appropriate license under Article 2 or Article 4 of this Chapter performs all work that falls within the classifications in Article 2 and 19 Article 4 of this Chapter." 20 SECTION 2. The State Licensing Board for General Contractors; State Board of 21 Examiners of Plumbing, Heating, and Fire Sprinkler Contractors; and State Board of Examiners 22 of Electrical Contractors may adopt temporary rules to implement the provisions of this act. 23 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2021. 24
