10	under which a full time faculty member of the rank of full time instructor or above, and any		
11	full time staff member of The University of North Carolina personnel may during the period of		
12	normal employment enroll for not more than three courses per year in The University of North		
13	Carolina free of charge for tuition and fees, provided such enrollment does not interfere with
