- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
  - SECTION 1. G.S. 75-35 reads as rewritten:

## 6 "§ 75-35. Simulation of checks and invoices.

No person engaged in commerce shall in any manner issue any writing which simulates or 7 resembles: (i) a negotiable instrument; or (ii) an invoice, unless the intended recipient has actually 8

contracted for goods, property, or services for which the issuer seeks proper payment. The 9

- inclusion of any disclaimer on the writing shall not be a defense to a violation of this section." 10
- **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2021. 11
