Short Title: Consumer Protection- Invoice Advertisements. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Rabon, Ford, and Alexander (Primary Sponsors). Referred to: Rules and Operations of the Senate April 5, 2021 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE USE OF DISCLAIMERS ON SIMULATED CHECKS OR INVOICES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 75-35 reads as rewritten: "§ 75-35. Simulation of checks and invoices. No person engaged in commerce shall in any manner issue any writing which simulates or resembles: (i) a negotiable instrument; or (ii) an invoice, unless the intended recipient has actually

contracted for goods, property, or services for which the issuer seeks proper payment. The

inclusion of any disclaimer on the writing shall not be a defense to a violation of this section." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2021.
