The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. Part 3 of Article 58 of Chapter 8 of the General Statutes is amended		
by adding a new section to read:		
"§ 58-58-96. Ability to change beneficiary.		
No life insurance company in this State shall prohibit the owner of a life insurance policy		
from making a change to a beneficiary of that owner's policy if the beneficiary was selected under		
fraudulent circumstances or false pretenses."		
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to life insurance		
policies issued, renewed, or amended on or after that date.
