8	will empower Black, Indigenous, and other Birthing People of color to navigate systems and		
9	mobilize to offer resources, services, and support for holistic maternal health, wellness,		
10	sustainable co	ommunities, and economic advancement; Now, therefore,	
11	The General	Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
12	SI	ECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund	to the MAAME
13	(Mobilizing A	African American Mothers through Empowerment), Inc., a nonpu	rofit organization,
14	the sum of	two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) in nonrecurring	ng funds for the
15	2021-2022 fis	scal year to fill the gap of services that exists for marginalized con	nmunities who are
16	in between p	poverty and financial stability. These funds shall be used to pr	ovide services to
17	mothers who	are not eligible to receive public services and support and not al	ble to afford these
18	resources pri	vately. MAAME, Inc., will provide education (as a means o	f empowerment),
19	support, doula services, and opportunities for economic advancement.		
20	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2021.
