The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. The North Carolina Department of Transportation (Department) shall		
study the cost and potential economic benefits of a commuter rail service linking dense		
population centers in the North Carolina Piedmont Triad. This study shall incorporate population		
and development growth projections through the year 2050. The study shall, at a minimum,		
include all of the following:		
(1	A phased construction plan in which projected highest-ridership recompleted first.	outes are
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(2	Winston-Salem, and High Point.	
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SECTION 2. No later than December 29, 2023, the Department shall report to the		
Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Transportation and the Fiscal Research Division on		
the results of the study and any recommendations for planning and construction of a commuter		
rail service in the Piedmont Triad.		
SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated from the Highway Fund to the Department		
of Transportation for the 2021-2022 fiscal year, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars		
(\$100,000) in nonrecurring funds may be used by the Department for this study.		
SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2021, and expires on December 29,
