A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE TECHNOLOGY AND DATA INSTITUTE 3 TO OPERATE A PILOT PROGRAM TO EXPAND HIGH-SPEED INTERNET ACCESS 4 TO STUDENTS OF LOW-INCOME FAMILIES IN CENTRAL NORTH CAROLINA. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State 7 Budget and Management the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for 8 the 2021-2022 fiscal year to allocate to the Technology and Data Institute, a public service consortium of public entities, including Guilford County Schools, the City of Greensboro, 9 10 Guilford County, North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University, and the University of North Carolina at Greensboro to operate a pilot program to expand high-speed internet access 11 12 to students of low-income families in central North Carolina, beginning with the 2021-2022 school year. The pilot program shall prioritize students without sufficient broadband access for 13 online learning and focus on developing a sustainable model for the design, building, and 14

- 15 operation of the technology infrastructure and services required to deliver high-quality and 16 easy-to-use internet access for all prekindergarten through postdoctoral students in the 12-county
- 17 Piedmont region of North Carolina.
