

7	SE	CTION 1. G.S. 116-143.1 is amended by adding the following new subsections
8	to read:	
9	" <u>(n)</u> <u>No</u>	twithstanding any other provision of this section, a person who meets all of the
10	following qualifications shall be accorded resident tuition status:	
11	<u>(1)</u>	
12		school within North Carolina or received a high school equivalency diploma
13		within North Carolina.
14	<u>(2)</u>	
15		consecutive years immediately prior to completing high school.
16	<u>(3)</u>	
17		Arrivals (DACA) initiative and provides documentation to the constituent
18		institution or community college to which the person is enrolled
19		demonstrating that the person is a DACA beneficiary.
20	<u>(4)</u>	
21		community college to which the person applied and has secured admission
22		and enrolled as a student at the constituent institution or community college.
23		y information obtained as part of the process of applying for in-State tuition
24	-	bsection (n) of this section shall be confidential and is not a public record."
25	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2021, and applies beginning with	
26	the 2021-2022	academic year.
