SECTION 1. G.S. 163-22 is amended by adding a new subsection to read	
"(s) Nothing in this Chapter shall grant authority to the State Board of Elections	-
private monetary donations, directly or indirectly, for conducting elections or e	mploying
individuals on a temporary basis."	
SECTION 2. G.S. 163-33 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read	
"(17) Nothing in this Chapter shall grant authority to county boards of el	
accept private monetary donations, directly or indirectly, for c	onducting
elections or employing individuals on a temporary basis."	
SECTION 3. G.S. 163-37 reads as rewritten:	
"§ 163-37. Duty of county board of commissioners.	
(a) The respective boards of county commissioners shall appropriate reason	
adequate funds necessary for the legal functions of the county board of elections,	including
reasonable and just compensation of the director of elections.	•
(b) Nothing in this Chapter shall grant authority to county boards of commis	
accept private monetary donations, directly or indirectly, for conducting elections or e	mploying
individuals under this Chapter on a temporary basis."	

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2021.
