The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Office of State Budget and Management
the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2022-2023 fiscal year
to provide a directed grant to Smithville Community Development Corporation, a nonprofit
corporation, to continue its work to save and protect the historically African American
neighborhood known as Smithville in the Town of Cornelius.
