A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE SMITHVILLE COMMUNITY		
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE SMITHVILLE COMMONITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE HISTORICALLY AFRICAN AMERICAN NEIGHBORHOOD KNOWN AS SMITHVILLE IN THE TOWN OF CORNELIUS.		
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
<b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated to the Office of State Budget and Management the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2022-2023 fiscal year to provide a directed grant to Smithville Community Development Corporation, a nonprofit corporation, to continue its work to save and protect the historically African American neighborhood known as Smithville in the Town of Cornelius. <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2022.
