A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REMOVE MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR COMMUNITY-FUNDED AND VOLUNTEER PRISON CHAPLAINS AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The Department of Public Safety shall have no written or unwritten policy setting mandatory minimum educational requirements for persons serving as community-funded or volunteer chaplains.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Safety the sum of seven hundred fifty-five thousand nine hundred four dollars (\$755,904) in recurring funds in the 2022-2023 fiscal year to be used to hire 10 full-time clinical chaplain

 positions. **SECTION 3.** Section 2 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2022. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
