)	2020 election is extended from September 2022 to September 2023. The State Board of Elections,	
)	in collaboration with county boards of elections, shall ensure 2020 election records and papers	
	are retained in accordance with this section.	
)	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 163-234(10) reads as rewritten:	
3	"(10) The county board of elections shall retain all container-return envelopes and	
Ļ	absentee ballots, in a safe place, for at least four 22 months, and longer if any	
í	contest is pending concerning the validity of any ballot."
