AN ACT TO REQUIRE ANNUAL NOTIFICATION OF HOME SCHOOL OPERATION AND TO PROHIBIT ESTABLISHMENT OF HOME SCHOOLS BY INDIVIDUALS CONVICTED OF CERTAIN CRIMES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Part 3 of Article 39 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes reads as rewritten:

"Part 3. Home Schools.

"§ 115C-563. Definitions.

As used in this Part or Parts 1 and 2 of this Article:

- (a) "Home school" means a Home School. A nonpublic school consisting of the children of not more than two families or households, where the parents or legal guardians or members of either household determine the scope and sequence of academic instruction, provide academic instruction, and determine additional sources of academic instruction.
- (b) "Duly authorized representative of the State" means the <u>Director</u>. The <u>Director</u>, Division of Nonpublic Education, or his <u>staff.or</u> her <u>designee</u>.
 - (c) Parent. A parent or legal guardian.

"§ 115C-564. Qualifications and requirements.

- (a) A home school shall make the election to operate under the qualifications of either Part 1 or Part 2 of this Article and shall meet the requirements of the Part elected, except that any as follows:
 - (1) Any requirement related to safety and sanitation inspections shall be waived if the school operates in a private residence and except that testing residence.
 - (2) <u>Testing</u> requirements in G.S. 115C-549 and G.S. 115C-557 shall be on an annual basis.
 - (3) Each home school shall have a chief administrator who is responsible for submission of all information required by the Director. The chief administrator shall be a parent of one or more children educated in the home school.
 - (4) The persons providing academic instruction in a home school shall hold at least a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- (b) By July 1 annually, the chief administrator of a home school shall submit to the Director a notice of intent to operate a home school. The information required in the notice of intent shall be established by the Director and shall include at least the following information:
 - (1) The name of the school.
 - (2) The name of the chief administrator.



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n. Any other violent felony, as defined in G.S. 14-7.7, where the victim was a minor child.

(2) The child has been removed from the parent's custody following an adjudication that the child is an abused or neglected juvenile under Chapter 7B of the General Statutes.

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SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to home schools operating beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.

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
